What to Bring to Your First Event

You have found the SCA and are ready to jump in and go to your first event. So now you need to know what to wear and what to bring.

The good news is that the general answer for this is NOTHING. Most groups have a Chatelaine or Gold Key Officer who loans garb and feast gear to newcomers. Contacting this person before the event will ensure you know what is available. This not only makes going to your first event easier, but it also allows you to see what other people wear and bring.

When you are ready to have your own gear, here is a list of suggestions to get you started. Remember, the goal is an attempt at pre-17th century appearance.

Feastgear – a plate, bowl, utensils and cup of wood, metal or ceramic/glass.

Camping Equipment - a camp chair or cooler with a piece of fabric thrown over it to disguise it.

Garb – either borrow garb or start simple. A simple “A Line” or “T Shaped” tunic is great for males or females. The only difference is the length with females tunics generally being longer. Plain dark colored pants are good for anyone. A simple black or brown belt is handy. For shoes, either simple boots, slip-ons or sandals in a dark leather work well. Women can wear a simple solid color veil or scarf pinned into the hair. Fabrics for clothing should be a natural fiber like cotton, wool or linen if possible.

Basket or Pouch – this is a great way to carry around all your belongings.

Sunscreen & Bug Spray – because most of our events are held at parks, these comfort items are usually very appreciated

Water – most groups provide a clean water source, but having your own water is advisable since keeping hydrated is very important at events.

Notebook and Pen – because you will want to take lots of notes! The people are a great resource for you as well. Feel free to ask questions about what they are wearing or what they have. Most are glad to share the information on where to find material or mugs, as well as ideas for garb. Use your first event as an opportunity to see all the different options out there before you pick a particular style or personae.

Cash – most groups only accept cash at registration the day of the event. Plus there are merchants for shopping and sometimes a fundraiser.

A few things to avoid because they are associated with specific designations.

- Belts – white, red, yellow and green all denote a particular association
- Spurs and Unadorned Chains – gold or silver, these are associated with knights or squires.
- Circlets, Crowns or Laurel Wreaths – these are worn by people who have had a specific rank bestowed upon them.

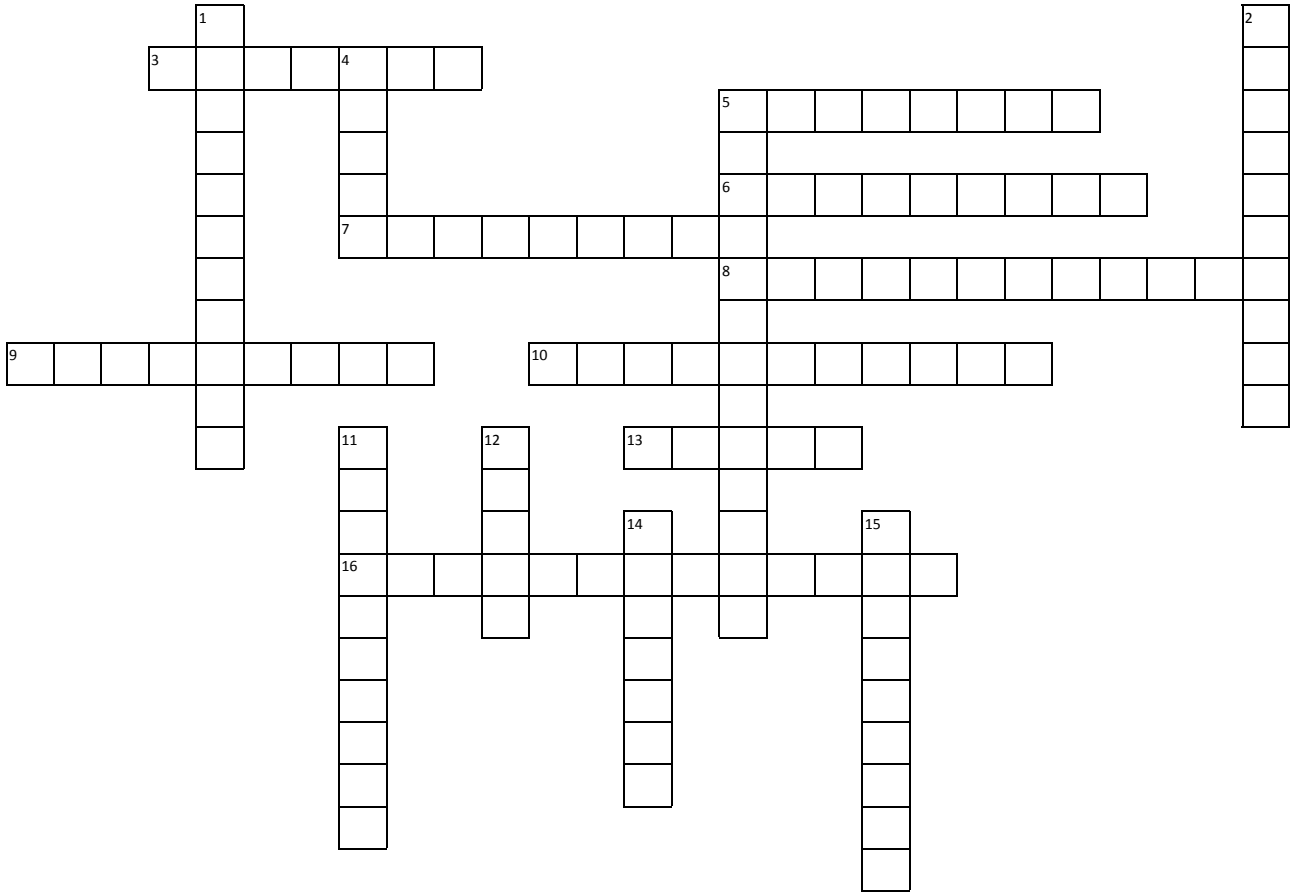

From the Sheriff...

Let me start off first saying, I need a Deputy. Now this may bring to your mind what is it that the Sheriff does. We are in charge of waivers for the group, that is the main function of the position. There are a few other functions but they are minor in comparison. If we do not process waivers properly, then we will cease to function as a group. It is also part of the Sheriff's Office to train others in how to do waivers and the troll procedures. It is really not hard to do, but the minor waiver requirements have been confusing to some, so I want to address that aspect here.

For Minors	Waiver requirements
Accompanied by parent/guardian, with current blue membership card	None
Accompanied by parent/guardian, without current membership	Consent to participate
Accompanied by non-parent/guardian , with current blue membership card	Designated Adult Form Medical Authorization
Accompanied by non-parent/guardian , without current membership	Consent to participate Designated Adult Form Medical Authorization

This is the best chart I have found that explains minor waiver requirements.

A minor is anyone aged 17 and under. The first and second box is for parents, step-parent, foster-parent, etc. and is asking if the minor has a blue card or is a non-member. If a non-member or the blue card is not available a Consent to Participate (minor waiver) needs to be filled out.

The third and fourth box applies when you bring any minor that is not your own, Note that you will need to bring with you the completed Designated Adult form and the Minor Medical Authorization form for each minor you bring. This must be the original documents signed by their parent. You also must have a copy, as the original must be filed at Troll and the copy kept with you during the event.

Some may think it harsh that we can not allow people to bring any minor they are not the parent/guardian of to events without the Designated Adult and Minor Medical Authorization forms. It is in the best interest of the minor that we have to enforce this. Should anything happen to minor, then you have full authority to direct a First Responder as to the care of the minor, these documents are proof of that.

Also note that the Designated Adult and Minor Medical Authorization forms do not need to be notarized if the event is within the Kingdom of Gleann Abhann. These documents are also required if you are taking the minor to any function that a waiver is required, such as a Fighter or Live Weapons Practice. These forms are available from the Kingdom Library under the Sheriff section.

I hope that this clears up the requirements. I know we sometimes do not think of these things as we tell our kids, sure you can bring your friend. Just remember that you have to bring the proper forms.

Best wishes for a happy and restful holiday and a fruitful new year.

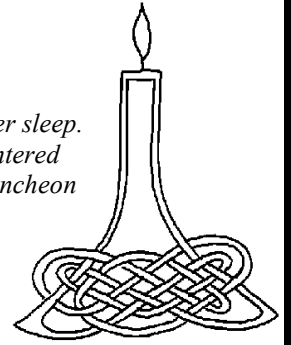
